FORMAT

Please include the following in your Letter of Intent. Margins should be at least 1/2" around, and the suggested font is Arial, 11 point. Forms for the application can be accessed through the EMZ Foundation's on-line applications system at ProposalCentral (<u>https://proposalcentral.altum.com/</u>).

1. Face Page

The face page should include the following information:

- Title of the Project
- Name of Principal Investigator and Title, Degree
- Principal Investigator Contact Information: Mailing Address; Phone Number; Fax Number; email address; Web site address.
- **2. Biographical Sketch:** Use the new (5-page) National Institutes of Health (NIH) Biosketch format, but include a <u>complete list of publications</u>. The information provided in the biographical sketch should include training, personal statement and professional experience.
- **3.** Current Funding: Include current funding status, the funding agency, award number, dates applicable, title, amount, and one or two sentences describing the content of the funded application/award.
- 4. Project Summary: Two-page maximum (not including references). Please use Arial 11 point font.

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Suggested Format:

- 1. Brief summary of the background of the proposal.
 - Briefly describe the context of the scientific problem.
- 2. Description of the Hypothesis/Specific Aims of the project.
 - Indicate the specific hypothesis or questions to be addressed.
- 3. Rationale.
 - Explain the rationale leading to the proposed research.
- 4. Experimental Approach/Methodology
 - Provide a framework for the experimental plan, with references where appropriate.
- 5. Summary and Impact
 - How will the successful completion of the proposed studies advance our understanding of vision or visual system disorders?

Proposal Submission:

The LOI should be submitted through the EMZ Foundation's on-line application system at ProposalCentral (<u>https://proposalcentral.altum.com/</u>).
